



Health and Safety Policy Statement

Our statement of general policy is:

- To provide suitable training to ensure all centre staff are competent in fulfilling their roles
- To prevent accidents and / or any cases of work-related ill health and to provide adequate management of health and safety risks occurring from any work-related activities
- To engage and consult with all centre staff on the day to day health and safety conditions and to provide advice, guidance and supervision on occupational health
- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions, also to ensure the safe storage and usage of substances
- To implement emergency procedures for evacuation in case of a fire and / or any other significant incident.

Centre Staff responsibility to:

- Take reasonable care of their own health and safety in the workplace, and that of others who may be affected by their actions
- Not to interfere with, misuse or damage anything that has been provided in the interests of health and safety
- Comply with the current legislative requirements included within the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974
- Co-operate with others within the workplace to fulfil their statutory duties.


This policy statement came into force on 10th March 2020
